Eligibility and Other Information

- Tuition is reduced from \$371.00 to \$195.00 per quarter credit hour. You must be a high school graduate or have a high school equivalent (GED) and be a first-time enrollee at Purdue Global (formerly Kaplan University).
- You must have a 2.75 cumulative grade point average on either your high school or college coursework if applicable.
- A leave of absence due to a military relocation is allowed.
- There are no entrance exams or college placement exams needed to enroll.
